Shotley and Erwarnton Parish Plan Questionnaire

As you may remember from our recent Newsletter, a Parish Plan Steering Committee has been formed to find out how our communities want to develop in the future. The Parish Plan process is a thorough exercise to raise interest in the village about how we can plan and build for the future. It should reflect the views of all sections of the community, it should identify features and local characteristics that people value; identify local problems and opportunities; spell out how residents would like the community to develop in the future, and prepare a plan of action to achieve this vision. It should be a vehicle to enable village groups working in conjunction with the Parish Council and Parish Meeting to apply for further funding to support a wide range of community projects. You can find the latest information on the Parish Plan on our website at www.myshotley.com.

In addition to a variety of public consultation meetings, we have prepared this detailed questionnaire which is now being delivered to every home in the Parishes, with a request for **everyone** in the household aged 11 and over to answer the questions. The main household questionnaire has two sections; (i) Household and, (ii) Individual. The household section contains questions which are to be answered by **one** representative of the household only. The Individual questions are to be answered by **all** members of the household aged 11 and over. Some questions will not apply to everyone, so please just put an N/A in the box if you feel that the question does not apply.

Young people form a vital part of our community and we are very keen to hear their views. If you are between the ages of 11 and 21 (inclusive) we also ask you to answer questions in the separate 'Young Peoples' questionnaire. Sorry for the extra work, but you will have opinions on matters of importance to both young people and adults. The Young Peoples questionnaire is designed so that **each** young person can have his or her own copy, and so if you do not have enough copies of the Youth Questionnaire please contact the Steering Committee at the telephone number/email below. The Young Peoples questionnaire will be collected at the same time as the main household questionnaire, and it is important that both are kept together for collection.

Please note that the questionnaires are completely anonymous, your name is not required. However, if you would like further information on issues raised or would like to assist or volunteer with anything, please fill in the separate sheet at the end of the questionnaire, tear it off, and hand it to the person who collects your completed questionnaire. These contact slips will be kept apart from the questionnaires when collected. There is also another separate tear off slip for you to register your contact details (email) if you would like to be kept informed of the activities of the Parish Plan Committee. As with all the details that you provide in the questionnaires, your responses will be treated in absolute confidentiality.

The questionnaires are being delivered to you by a team of volunteers. They will give you all the help you need to complete the questionnaire and ensure that as many as possible are returned. Your questionnaires will be collected on the date that you agreed when it was delivered (written at the bottom of the front cover).
