

SUFFOLK SAVER – CHANGES FROM 01/04/08

The new English National Concessionary Bus Travel Scheme will replace the Suffolk Saver from the 1st April 2008.

From 01/04/08 Valid National Pass Holders will be able to travel free on any **ENGLISH LOCAL BUS** between 9.30 am and 11.00 pm Monday to Friday and all day Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holidays. **Babergh Pass Holders will have the**



additional benefit of free local bus travel throughout the day every day within Suffolk. Babergh residents aged 60 years and over and people with disabilities can apply (see below) for the New National Bus Pass. It costs nothing.

Babergh Pass Holders will be able to use it on all Local Bus Services, the Buzabout Community Car and, after 9.30 a.m., for fare reductions on the Shotley, Harwich and Felixstowe Foot Ferry

(a charge of £1 per person per river will be made – i.e. £2 for Shotley to Felixstowe). Off Peak local bus travel will also be allowed anywhere in England, including local London bus travel, but not any English train, underground or tram travel nor is it valid in Wales, Scotland or N. Ireland.
