- More sports in general

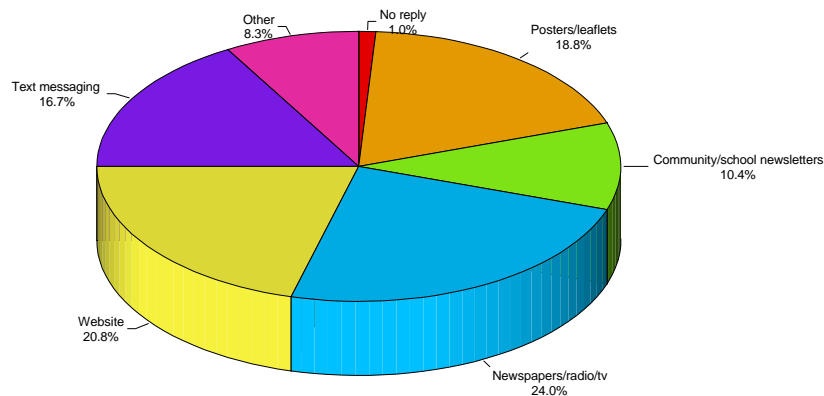

- Not enough lighting

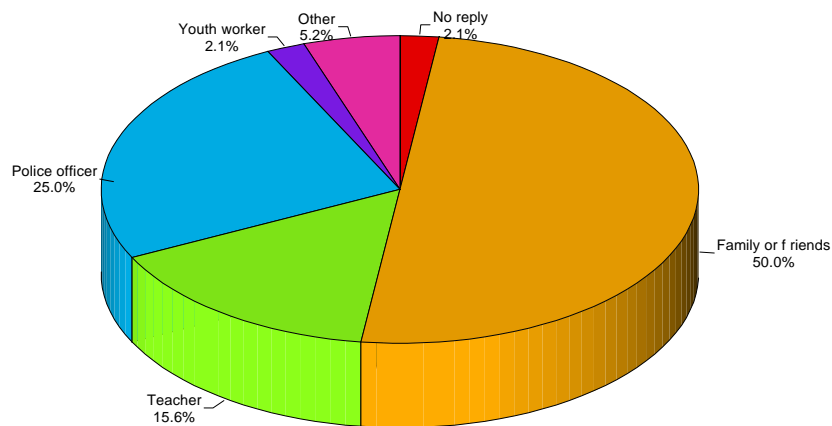

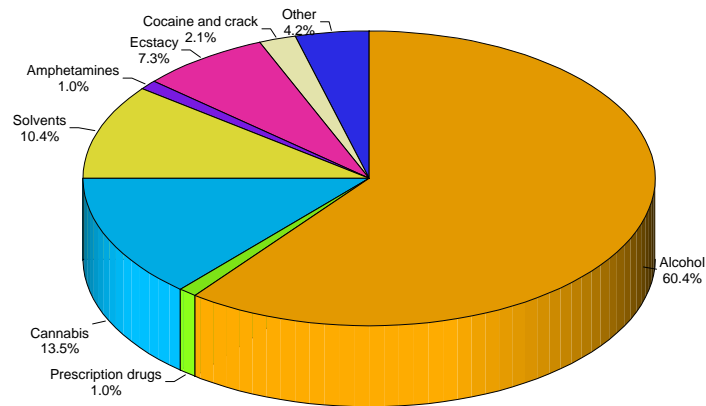

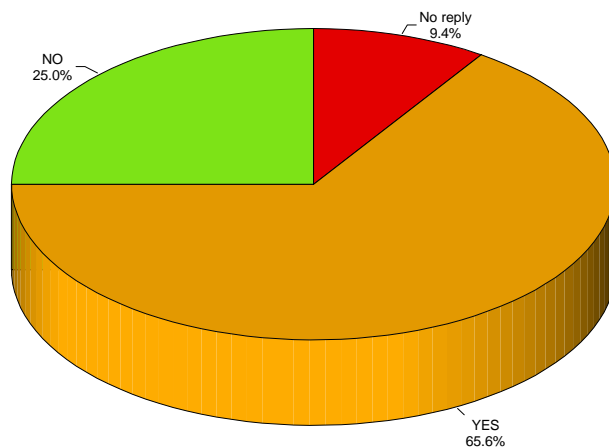
**11. Is substance misuse (drugs and alcohol) a problem within Shotley Peninsula?**



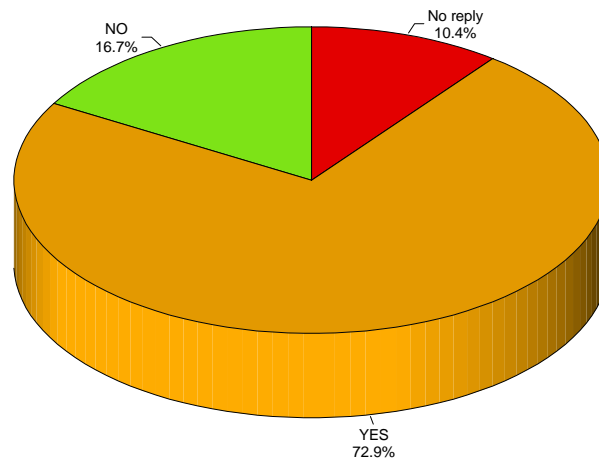
**12. To the best of your knowledge, which substance is most prevalent within the area?**



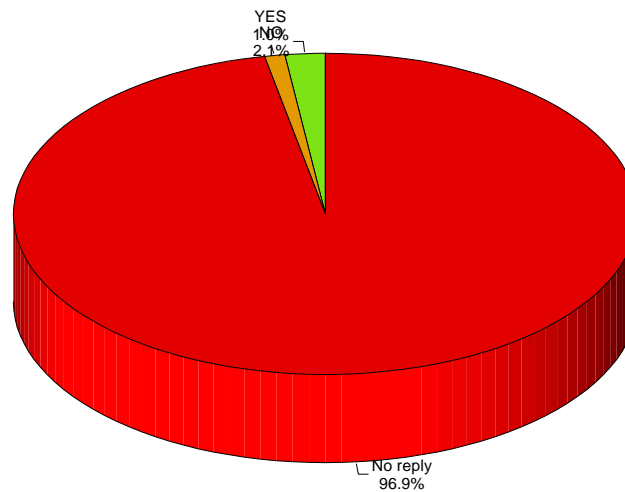

- It would be great to have somewhere for teenagers to meet
- Seems to be lack of 'community spirit' in Shotley

- Put 'youth' first on P. Council list
- Should be more organised sports activities for under 18 year olds
- Recent trouble in Shotley is due mostly to boredom caused by lack of facilities
- More regular public transport between villages and Ipswich
- Shotley is a great place to live but would be better if it catered for more youth activities
- Young people should be encouraged to have more of a say with what we want
- More regular transport to Ipswich especially at night and weekends
- Facilities listed are not available in Shotley
- The Parish Council do not seem to want to include young people in the community - hence the hall is only used for the under 10's or the over 50's
- Lack of support from 'significant people' in Shotley re young peoples needs
- Cannabis easy to get in this area due to docks etc
- Perhaps 'young people' should be more involved in what goes on in Shotley
- Shotley appears to be a wealthy area, so it seems strange that no money put into doing more for teenagers
- In Shotley a lot as my boyfriend lives here. Nothing here for youngsters compared to choice I have in Ipswich
- Although too old for 'youth activities' have a younger brother who would greatly appreciate more to do in Shotley
- Have a small daughter & it is a shame I will have to move to Ipswich so she will have a choice of activities and that Shotley people 'talk' but dont take action
- Community Centre - youth not allowed
- Some type of youth club facilities would be good
- Only place to hang out with friends is the public toilets
- Not just Shotley kids, as a lot of kids from surrounding areas hang out in Shotley
- A youth club would be a bonus
- A disco in community centre would help
- More buses
