Report from Sector Commander

I am pleased to report that February saw a further reduction in reported crime - 120 offences compared to the 180 recorded in February 2006.

We are still being troubled by thefts from motor vehicles, which could easily be avoided through basic crime prevention. The bottom line is if it's on view, someone may try to steal it - even loose change! The inconvenience and cost of repairs will often be far higher than the value of the item stolen.

Calls for service dropped in February to 642, compared with 704 for February 2006.
